



Scaffolding



Description

There are several risks associated with assembling a scaffold and this practice requires advanced technical knowledge. Regulatory provisions require that scaffolding must be erected by qualified personnel.

Target Audience

Workers having to assemble modular or metal frame scaffolding of less 18 metres (60 ft).

Objectives

- Be able to assemble and dismantle a scaffold;
- Know the rules and standards that apply to scaffolding;
- Be able to inspect a scaffold.
